PROGRAMS AND SERVICES, A-Z

HHSA offers these Public Health programs & services:

Adult Health/BCCCP

Physical exams for males and females. Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP) with mammograms and cervical cancer screenings for women 50-64 years.

Child Health

- Well check visits—*preventative health services for children ages 3-21, following guidelines established by the American Academy of Pediatrics. Visits include history & physical; vision, hearing and developmental screenings.*
- Testing—for Anemia, Lead Poisoning, or chronic diseases as indicated.
- School Health Assessments
- Sports Physicals
- College Physicals

We do not provide primary care services or sick visits; we encourage you to become established with a primary care provider.

Communicable Disease

Screening, diagnosis, and treatment of STDs including HIV testing. TB diagnosis and treatment. Other communicable disease screening, control and intervention.

Dental Office

Comprehensive exams, dental hygiene, extractions, fillings, partials, dentures, crowns and bridges; serving children and adults.

Environmental Health

Inspections and permitting of water supplies, wells and septic systems; and food, lodging and other institutions.

Family Planning

Birth control and other services and education to females and males of childbearing age to prevent unintended pregnancies and STDs. *No one is denied services because of inability to pay; services and educational materials are funded in part by Title X.*

Free Hepatitis B & C testing for certain groups at risk

Health Education/Preparedness & Response (PHP&R)

Health Education: health programs, data, reporting, and Healthy Haywood coalition. PHP&R helps the county prevent, prepare for, respond to and recover from public health emergencies.

Immunization Clinic & Foreign Travel

Childhood and adult immunizations; counseling and immunizations for foreign travel.

Laboratory

Water analysis; rabies specimens; infectious disease screenings; and many other laboratory services as medically indicated.

Pregnancy Testing & Prenatal Services

Pregnancy counseling, testing, referrals and prenatal education.

School Nursing

Each Haywood County Consolidated system school has an assigned Public Health Nurse to coordinate health services for children with special needs; provide health assessments, screenings, referrals and health education and promotion.

Vital Records

County birth and death certificates.

WIC

WIC is a federally funded program that provides nutrition education, supplemental food and breastfeeding support for eligible pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants, and children up to 5.
