THE PINK RELAY

This unique race is an all-women's relay covering 20 miles between five team members. Each relay team member will run the same four-mile loop course, which includes Jones Cove Road and the property of Haywood Community College. This course enhances runner safety, alleviates traffic congestion and creates a festive atmosphere, where each relay member will be able to watch their teammates start and finish at Haywood Regional Health & Fitness Center.

THE PINK 4-MILER RUN / WALK

This race is open to MALE and FEMALE runners and walkers of all ages. The 4-miler race uses the same course as the Pink Relay. The course is a moderately hilly track on Jones Cove Road and the Haywood Community College property, beginning and ending at Haywood Regional Health and Fitness Center. There will be three water stations along the course.

THE BUBBLE GUM FUN RUN / WALK

Everyone is encouraged to embrace the **Power of Pink**. This event is designed for young children, non-athletes and those who cannot participate in the other events to be involved. The entire course will be located on the HRMC campus and cover less than a mile. Each participant will receive a recognition token.

TIMING

The Pink Relay and The Pink 4-Miler Run/Walk will utilize automatic timing; the Bubble Gum Fun Run/Walk will not be timed. Splits will be taken for each relay leg and called at the one and two mile points of the 4-Miler.

COMMEMORATIVE T-SHIRT

Each Pink Relay team member will receive a long-sleeve T-shirt. The first 200 Pink 4-Miler registrants are guaranteed to receive a short sleeve T-shirt. All T-shirts will be technical running shirts.

Awards

PINK RELAY - Each member of the top three relay teams will receive a special prize designed specifically for this event.

THE PINK 4-MILER - Prizes will be awarded to the top male and female overall finishers and the top male and female masters finishers. Age group prizes for male and female will be awarded for first, second and third in the following age groups: 10 & under, 11-14, 15-20, 21-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, and 70 & over. No double dipping.
